A. COUNSELLING & ADMISSION COMMITTEE & ITS FUNCTION: -

The Committee is constituted consisting of;

- 1. Special Secretary (M.S) to Govt. Health & FW Department Chairman
- 2. Director Health Services, Odisha
- 3. Director, Medical Education & Training, Odisha
- 4. Additional Director, Medical Education & Training Odisha
- 5. Additional Director (HRH & Research), Odisha

The Committee will function in the office of the Directorate Health Services, Govt. of Odisha, and will carry out the following works. The Counseling Committee shall:

- 1. Prepare the seat matrix for counseling, incorporating the reservation policy.
- 2. Coordinate and verify all the process of application, selection and admission to be conducted by the CPS, Mumbai
- 3. The Chairman will be the controlling & supervising authority and must see that the counseling and admissions are done in strict conformity with the rules laid down and notify the tentative dates. He will approve the budget of expenditure and will release funds in time for smooth counseling and admission.
- 4. The Convener is authorized to file affidavits in legal matters on behalf of the Chairman, Counseling Committee, and Govt., float advertisements, convene meetings, and conduct counseling/allotment/admission strictly as per the guidelines in consultation with the Committee members. He is the custodian of all documents including vouchers of expenditure of counseling process and will produce as and when required. All expenditures shall be made strictly as per the Govt. approved guidelines. A savings bank account shall be opened in the name of "Convener Counseling & Admission Committee, DHS Odisha" in any nationalized bank for transaction of all sale proceeds and other receipts from candidates.

B. COMMENCEMENT OF SESSION:

F. RESERVATION OF SEATS:

The reservation percentage will be 67% for UR category, 12% for ST category, 8% for SC category, 5% for PH and 5 % for Green Card (GC) category and 3% for Ex-Servicemen (Ex-S) category.

Note1: Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe persons who have migrated from their State of Origin to some of her State for the purpose of seeking education, employment etc. Will be deemed to be scheduled Caste/Tribe of the State of their Origin and will get privilege from the State of origin and not from the State to which they have migrated. (Vide Govt. of India Letter No. BC/16014/1/82-SC& BCD/Dated: 22nd February 1985).

Note2: Seats reserved for S.T. and S.C. candidates are to be filled up by the applicants belonging to the respective community as per the Odisha Caste Certificate (for S.C. and S.T.) Rules–1980 and as amended from time to time by Government of Odisha and are not interchangeable.

Note3: Seats reserved for physically challenged (PH) will be filled up by the candidates with benchmark disabilities in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with disabilities Act, 2016 the details is as per Appendix- I, provided that in case any seat in this 5% Quota remains unfilled on account of unavailability of candidates then such unfilled seat/s

Note4: Candidates claiming under Green Card category must produce the Green Card in original of their parents, and must not have taken the privilege of reservation using the same card before. The facts & figures mentioned in the Green Card must tally with other relevant certificates submitted. In case of any discrepancy the claim under Green card reservation will not be considered. However, he/she will be treated under unreserved category.

Note5: To be eligible for reservation under Ex-servicemen category, the candidate must be: (a)A Permanent Resident of Odisha (b) Son/daughter/spouse of a person who was in defense service OR the candidate himself/herself has served in defense service. (Ex-servicemen mean persons who worked in Army / Navy / Air Force and who come under the definition of Ex- servicemen in vogue at the time of their discharge / retirement). Such candidates must produce certificate from Rajya Sainik Board, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, regarding their eligibility under Ex-servicemen category. Candidates who themselves or their parents are continuing in defense service at the time of application are not eligible for reservation under this category.

G. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be *eligible* a candidate must have passed MBBS [from an MCI/NMC recognized institution / qualified Foreign Medical Graduates Examination - MCI FMGE] and must have the following criteria:

1. The candidate must be a permanent resident of Odisha

2. The candidate must have appeared in NEET PG-2022 with the following qualifying conditionality:

- a. New score will be decided after adding 10%, 20% & 30% of the score secured in NEET 2022 for the candidates having 1 year, 2 year, and 3 or more than 3 years of experience respectively. [e.g.: For the candidate having 3 years of experience: 300 (NEET score) + 90 (30% of NEET score) = 390 is the new score].
- b. The working experience under department of health and family welfare as contractual, adhoc or regular shall only be taken into consideration. The revised score should be equal to or above the qualifying cut-off score set by MOH&FW for NEET PG-2022.
- 3. At the time of application, s/he must be employed on regular basis under the Dept. of Health & Family Welfare Government of Odisha. Provided that at the time of application the candidates must be in regular service and must have at least 10 years of service in hand before superannuation.
- 4. Candidates who have completed or undergoing P.G (Medical) course in any subject shall not be eligible to participate in the counseling process.
- N.B:
- a. Candidates can apply for the change of seats after the completion of the 1st round of allotment against the available vacant seats only within two days of 1st round seat allotment.
- b. No interchanging of seats shall be allowed once the process of seat allotment is done.

H. APPLICATION PROCESS

After the completion of document candidates' names will be screened for the 1st round of counseling and provisional allotment of seats. (Final Allotment shall be sent by CPS, Mumbai with allotment Number).

I. SELECTION PROCESS

L. DUTIES, ATTENDANCE, SALARY & LEAVES:

- 1. Students shall be deputed to the respective institutions in their respective department and may be assigned with the duties by the medical superintendent or any other concerned higher authorities of their respective institutions.
- 2. Students will be assigned with regular duties under the department in which they have been allotted to pursue the course.

Appendix I

(Refer Regulation 4 & 5)

A SCHEDULE is annexed regarding, "SPECIFIED DISABILITY" clause (zc) of section 2, that states as under,

1. Physical disability

- A. Locomotor disability- (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including—
 - (a) "leprosy cured person" means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from— (i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eyelid but with no manifest deformity; (ii)manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economic activity; (iii)extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall construed accordingly;
 - (b) "cerebral palsy" means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;
 - (c) "dwarfism" means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less; (d) "muscular dystrophy" means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterized by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;
 - (d) "Acid attack victims" means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment—

- (a) "blindness" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction— (i) total absence of sight; or (ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; or (iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.
- (b) "low-vision" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:
 (i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 up to 3/60 or up to 10/200 (Snelling) in the better eye with best possible corrections; or (ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degree.

C. Hearing impairment –

- (a) "deaf" means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
- (b) "hard of hearing" means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;

(c) "Speech and language disability" means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic or neurological causes.

2. Intellectual disability-

a condition characterized by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behavior which covers a range of every day, social and practical skills, including—

- (a) "specific learning disabilities" means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;
- (b) "Autism spectrum disorder" means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals or behaviors.
- 3. Mental behavior- "mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behavior, capacity to recognize reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person, specially characterized by sub-normality of intelligence.

4. Disability caused due to-

- (a) chronic neurological conditions, such as— (i) "multiple sclerosis" means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with each other; (ii) "Parkinson's disease" means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity, and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.
- (b) Blood disorder—(i) "hemophilia" means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their male children, characterized by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor would may result in fatal bleeding; (ii) "thalassemia" means a group of inherited disorders characterized by reduced or absent amounts of hemoglobin. (iii) "Sickle cell disease" means a hemolytic disorder characterized by chronic anemia, painful events, and various complications due to associated tissue and organ damage; "hemolytic" refers to the destruction of the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of hemoglobin.

- 5. **Multiple Disabilities** (more than one of the above specified disabilities) include deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.
- 6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.

Note: Any amendment to the Schedule to the RPWD Act, 2016, shall consequently stand amended in the aboveschedule.

Sub: Execution of Bond by candidates, while taking admission to different Diploma courses in the State.

Where as there is a dearth of doctors in the State and there is a reluctance to serve the State after completion of course amongst the doctors studying in different Government Health Institutions at the cost of State exchequer, in order to overcome the dearth, Government after careful consideration have been pleased to introduce a policy for execution of an agreement in shape of Bond with the objective to retain the passing out Diploma doctors to utilise their services in the greater interest of the State.

This resolution will be applicable from the date of notification.

1. The Bond conditions shall be as follows:

- a. Bond shall be applicable for all candidates taking admission in Government Health Institutions, for PG Diploma Courses.
- b. No admission of any kind shall be done without submission of Bond and shall be ensured by DHS, Odisha.
- c. After completion of any of the above courses, the candidates shall have to serve in any health institution of the state, for five years.
- d. After completion of five years of service as per bond provision, the doctors will be released from bond condition.
- e. In case a candidate gets opportunity for higher study immediately after completion of course, the bond seizes to operate and will come in to force after return from study. They shall submit a declaration in form of affidavit before JMFC as per format enclosed in **Appendix-1**, to that effect. In such cases the Pass certificate and CLC shall be released. Copy of such affidavit shall be sent to DHS Odisha.
- f. Monetary Penalty for defaulters (for not serving in state for five years after completion of course) shall be double the amount of salary received during study period. The Pass Certificates, College Leaving Certificate or any other certificate in custody of authority shall be retained and will be released only after compliance to the provisions in bond.

- g. Candidates leaving the course before completion of the course leading to lapse of a seat shall be liable for monetary penalty of Rs. 8 lakh and the amount of salary received by the date of such leaving the course.
- 2. Procedure for execution of bond and its follow up:
 - a. The bonds are to be prepared on non judicial stamp paper of Rs. 21 and will not be registered.
 - b. The bond should be signed by the candidate, two sureties (parents / guardian) and the DHS Odisha.
 - c. Bonds shall be collected centrally at the time of document verification by the selection committee.
 - d. All the candidates shall submit the bond in the format annexed at Annexure - A. as per FDOM 6874/F, dated 20.02.1996

BOND BY THE CANDIDATE AT THE TIME OF TAKING ADMISSION INTO PG (MD/MS/MDS) OR SUPERSPECIALITY (DM/MCH) COURSE IN GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES OF THE STATE OF ODISHA

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT WE..... son/ daughter/ wife of..... (hereinafter called "the surety") do here by jointly and severally bind ourselves and our respective heirs, executors and administrators and legal representative to pay the Governor of Odisha, his successors and assigns (hereinafter called "the Government") on demand, the amount equivalent to double the amount of stipend/salary for two years of study that the Government incurs on account of a candidate having been placed on PG Diploma Course till completion of the said course.

WHEREAS the Above Principal Obligor is placed on admission into PG Diploma Course and admissible by the Government;

AND WHEREAS for better protection of the healthcare of the Government in the State, the Principal Obligor has agreed to execute this bond with such condition as hereunder written;

AND WHEREAS the said surety has agreed to execute this bond as surety for the discharge of the above burden of the amount equivalent to double the amount of salary for two years of study by the Principal Obligor.....

NOW THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE WRITTEN BOND is that in the event of successful learning and completion of PG Diploma Course and obtaining registration thereof the Principal Obligor.....is to render five years of service in the State of Odisha. In case the Principal Obligor fails to comply due to any reason, the Principal Obligor is liable for refund of an amount equivalent to double the amount of salary for two years of study, to the Government of Odisha.

Appointment under the State Government in Health & FW Department after successful completion of PG Diploma Course shall mean and include regular appointment only. Once an appointment is given, the candidate shall have to join within 30 days from the date of receipt of the appointment order failing which, he /she will be required to pay the amount as calculated above.

Further in the event of leaving the course due to any reason before the completion of PG Diploma Course, leading to lapse of a seat, the Principal Obligor......is liable for refund of an amount of 08.00 lakhs (Rupees eight lakhs) and all the salary received till the date of leaving the course, to the Government of Odisha.

AND UPON in Principal Obligor.....

and..... the surety (ies) as aforesaid making such refund, the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue and it is agreed and declared by the Principal Obligor and the surety (ies) that in the event of default without prejudice to other remedies that the Government may adopt, the Government shall be entitled to recover the aforesaid amount from the Principal Obligor and the Sureties jointly and severally in the form of public demand under the Odisha Public Demand Recovery Act, 1962.

Save and except death, permanent disability or selection for higher study under no circumstances, the Principal Obligor can forgo the appointment and posting and if it so happens he shall be liable to refund the money amounting to the amount equivalent to double the amount of salary for two years of study.

PROVIDED that the liability of the surety hereunder shall not be impaired or discharged by reason of time being granted by the Government or by any forbearance, act or omission on the part of the Government or any person authorized by it (wherever with or without the consent or knowledge of the surety nor shall it be necessary for the Government to sue the said Principal Obligor before suing the above bounden surety...... on any of them for the amount due hereunder.

Provided further that, in case of selection for higher study this bond will be seized to be operative till the study is completed and will be deemed to be in force on the date of completion of higher study and accordingly, all the above mentioned clauses will be in operation for all purposes.
